## The Way Forward

This is to give you formal notice of a resolution unanimously passed at our Committee meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> March:

**Resolution:** That Clause 4 (b) (iv) of the Agreement between SeniorNet Learning Centres and The SeniorNet Federation be amended by the addition of the words "Will strive to" before the words "Organise member days"

**Rationale:** We support the concept of this agreement and agree with the wording in all but this regard. We believe the rest of Clause 4 is achievable, even by a small Centre like ours. However, the resources of small Centres will be overly stretched if the wording of Clause 4 (b) (iv) is passed as it is, when our other activities; courses, sworkshops, interest groups, are ongoing. No doubt the Federation will be asking for reports on level of compliance and if the words we are seeking are added, we would be able to justify the reasons for our non-compliance thus giving the Federation some oversight of the efforts we have made.
