Google Docs is a web based program accessible from anywhere, on is a virtually any computer with an internet connection and a web browser.



Google Docs is a free program.

Google Docs can be used off line and will upload the file next time internet access is resumed.

15GB of Free Cloud Storage is provided but this is shared with G-Mail files and images.

Open a folder in Google Docs containing three sub folders.

Comments were received to the effect that some learning centres did not know what Google Docs were or how to access them.


POSSIBLE SOLUTION

Public setting means that the file will be available to anyone searching for that topic.
